Parking: There is no charge for parking. At the Omaha site, parking is available on tier one directly south of the clubhouse. Overflow parking is available at the second and third tiers. At the Lincoln site, please view parking map below.

Admission: Admission is free to media and general public at both sites, however please have credentials visible. A face covering is required to enter the venue. A face covering will be required at all times for media, spectators, non-participating athletes and coaches when indoors.

Check-In: Media check-in locations: Lincoln-Woods Tennis Center Clubhouse, NSAA Headquarters Table; Omaha-Clubhouse, NSAA Headquarters Table. A championship program along with any other additional contest information will be available to media members at these locations.

Conduct/Etiquette: As members of the media, you are representing your media organization. Team attire (i.e. booster buttons, school team shirts, etc.) will not be permitted by members of the media. Cheering directed toward a specific school or participant will not be allowed. Our goal is to maintain equity in the competitive environment.

*Also, please have cell phones on silent when a match is in play.

Photographs: Photographers are not allowed to shoot photos on the court without permission or any area deemed inappropriate by onsite staff. Your cooperation is appreciated with this matter.

Interviews: Interviews are at the discretion of the coaches before/after matches. Interviews will not be conducted on the courts.


