- Column 1      Total school enrollment
- Column 2      Number of boys enrolled
- Column 3      Number of girls enrolled
- Column 4      Percentage of boys enrolled (Column 2 divided by Column 1)
- Column 5      Percentage of girls enrolled (Column 3 divided by Column 1)
- Column 6      Number of boys' sports offered
- Column 7      Number of girls' sports offered
- Column 8      Total duplicated athletes (boys & girls) (Column 9 plus Column 11)
- Column 9      Number of boy athletes (duplicated – see example)
- Column 10     Percentage of boy athletes (Column 9 divided by Column 8)
- Column 11     Number of girls athletes (duplicated – see example)
- Column 12     Percentage of girl athletes (Column 11 divided by Column 8)
- \*Column 13    Boys difference (Column 10 minus Column 4)
- \*Column 14    Girls difference (Column 12 minus Column 5)

### **EXAMPLE**

Calculate the duplicated or total participation rate:

Count the total number of participants by gender for all sports offered, double or triple counting students who participate in more than one sport. This rate provides a measure of total number of sports participations being offered for each gender by the athletic program.

- Co-ops: The school that houses the program counts the sports but each school counts their participants.
- A student can only be counted if he/she participates in the required number of practices and competes in a scrimmage or contest.
- Football and wrestling are boy's sports; girls are counted as participants. (The NSAA does not offer co-ed sports.)
