COMMITTEE ON RE-DISTRICTING, GOVERNANCE AND REPRESENTATION**

Minutes of August 3, 2011 Meeting

The Redistricting, Governance and Representation Committee met on Wednesday, August 3, 2011, at 8:30 a.m. at Sunrise Middle School in Kearney. Dr. Bob Reznicek chaired the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to review the May 4, 2011 Committee action and to decide where we go from here with proposals.

Chairman Bob Reznicek reviewed with the committee the major points of the May 4th meeting, and then proceeded to address the sub-committee recommendations in regard to re-districting and representation.

It was moved by Jeff Johnson, seconded by Jay Bellar, to proceed with the development of legislation addressing Class Caucuses. Motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Cindy Huff, seconded by Jerry Rempe to recognize NSAA boundaries as illustrated in Revision IV with the county lines encompassing the current district alignments with no change in the schools currently assigned to their respective district. **Motion Carried, 13 For** (Norvell, Johnson, McMahon, Henrichs, Bartee, Huff, Maher, Rempe, Muller, Watkins, Holliday, Hand, Reznicek) **5 Against** (Jeff Bellar, Jay Bellar, Egr, Wacker, Unzicker).

It was moved by Jeff Bellar, seconded by Michelle Egr to move Revision VII forward which basically leaves the current district lines as they currently exist. **Motion Carried, 11 For** (Schoneman, Maher, Jeff Bellar; Jay Bellar, Watkins, Egr, Wacker, Unzicker, Reznicek, Garey, Hand) **5 Against** (Dolliver, Johnson, Bartee, Huff, Holliday).

It was moved by Dennis Dolliver, seconded by Jeff Johnson, to meet again to re-visit the issue in regard to NSAA District boundaries. Motion passed unanimously.

With no further business, the committee stood adjourned at 9:48 a.m.
