Reznicek called the meeting to order at 8:43 a.m.

1. The Consent Agenda was approved on a motion by Unzicker, seconded by Wiseman. **Motion Carried, 8-0.** Items approved on the Consent Agenda included: approval of the agenda as presented, and approval of the minutes of the May 17<sup>th</sup> Board of Directors meeting.

2. It was moved by Keyser, seconded by Wiseman to approve a 50% reimbursement to schools for the 2020-21 school year. **Motion Carried, 8-0.**
3. It was moved by Lee, seconded by Wiseman to increase sub-district, district and state championship ticket prices by \$1. **Motion Carried, 8-0.**
4. It was moved by Cerny, seconded by Keyser to approve the digital ticketing contract with GoFan contingent upon clarifying the terms related to member schools use when hosting sub-districts and districts. **Motion Carried, 8-0.**
5. It was moved by Keyser, seconded by Drews to approve the hold the 2022 State Speech Championships at Kearney High School on March 16, 17 and 18. **Motion Carried, 8-0.**
6. The Board discussed the championship procedures used over the 2021-22 school year because of COVID-19.
7. It was moved by Lee, seconded by Drews to hold the 2021 State Volleyball Championships November 3, 4, 5 and 6. **Motion Carried, 8-0.**
8. It was moved by Keyser, seconded by Wiseman to host the 2022, 2023 and 2024 Class A and Class B State Baseball Championship at Werner Park and UNO's Tal Anderson Field.
