Fan Parking

Campus Parking Lots are not available during the day on Monday or Tuesday. The parking garage at 14th and Avery, will be available for parking during all games. All University lots around the stadium will be staffed during games on Monday and Tuesday, allowing only University and business permits to enter. Handicapped parking located on the west side of Memorial Stadium, especially in the parking garage, is closer to the main handicapped entrance at Gate 3. Additional parking is available just west of the stadium in the INS Parking Lot, entrance on 8th Street.

Stadium Restrictions

As a reminder to fans, umbrellas and talcum/baby powder are not allowed at Memorial Stadium. Artificial noise makers such as thunder sticks, cow bells, air horns, whistles, etc. are prohibited at NSAA championship events. All students and spectators are required to wear shirts. Spectators are allowed to bring stadium seats. The clear bag policy will not be enforced at Memorial Stadium.
