COMMITTEE ON SUMMER BYLAW REVIEW**

Meeting Minutes

The Committee on Summer Bylaw Review met on Wednesday, August 3, 2021, via Zoom. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. CST by Kathi Wieskamp, NSAA District 1 Board of Director, who chaired the meeting.

Ex-officio members included NSAA Staff, Jay Bellar and Jennifer Schwartz.

Wieskamp recapped the last meeting where it was decided to prioritize coach/player contact and to provide opportunities for all kids during the summer.

The committee members shared information from the member schools in their legislative districts.

The committee decided to modify the current NSAA Summer Bylaws to allow each school district to determine its own policies regarding the use of school facilities and school equipment. The committee will share the revisions with those in their respective legislative districts and then submit a legislative proposal for consideration this fall.

The committee also discussed the idea of a summer moratorium. The committee decided to survey NSAA member schools for feedback.
