## Ceremonial First Pitchers

### Tammy Nielsen-Winkler

Whether she was in the circle for the Fremont Tigers or Creighton Bluejays, Tammy Nielsen was one of the most durable and prolific pitchers who calls the state of Nebraska home.



Nielsen was a three-time All-Nebraska pitcher from 1998 through 2000. She still owns two all-class and two Class A state records.

The all-class records are career pitching wins (115) and career strikeouts (1,548). Nielsen remains the Class A standard bearer with 20 career no-hitters (excluding 3-inning games) and 18 consecutive strikeouts.

She led the Tigers to three consecutive Class A state tournaments, including a third place finish in the 1999 event at Omaha's Seymour Smith Park. Nielsen was named to The World-Herald's Silver Anniversary team in 2018 that honored the top 25 players in the history of the sport in the state of Nebraska.

In her senior season, the team was 31-9 and Nielsen had a 0.54 ERA with her career high strikeouts recorded of 463 in one season. She was honored by Sports Illustrated in Faces in the Crowd on Oct. 9th, 2000 after becoming Nebraska's first 100-game winner.

Nielsen spent her Freshman year at Augustana, recording 256 strikeouts with a 0.70 ERA. She earned NCC Pitcher of the Week recognition twice, while abtting .305, with three home runs and 20 RBI.

Nielsen was Creighton's ace for three seasons – 2003 through 2005. She pitched every inning in 10 straight victories at the Missouri Valley Conference tournament while leading the Bluejays to three consecutive league tournament titles.

She was the first pitcher in school history to post three 20-win seasons, and also was a three-time All-MVC first team selection. Nielsen also is the only pitcher in conference history with multiple seasons of 300 or more strikeouts. Her career total of 914 Ks is still second in school history.

As a junior in 2004, Nielsen pitched five no-hitters. That was one of the achievements that led Nielson to be named MVC Pitcher of the Year and earn second-team All-America honors. Nielson still is in the top three in Creighton history in shutouts, strikeouts, wins, appearances, complete games, innings pitched and starts.

Tammy was inducted into the Creighton Hall of Fame in 2015.

### Kaylan Jablonski

Kaylan Jablonski carved her place in Nebraska high school softball history by leading Omaha Skutt to its first two Class B state championships. A three-time first team All-Nebraska selection and the Nebraska Gatorade Player of the Year following her senior season in 2013, Jablonski then had a stellar career at the University of Nebraska.



As she led the Skyhawks to those two state championships, Jablonski also posted several state record-setting numbers. Her .557 career batting average was an all-class and Class B state record, and she also set Class B career records for home runs (25) and RBIs (137).

In the circle Jablonski posted a career record of 81-14 with an ERA of 1.50. She was the nation's No. 5 recruit by Student Sports after committing to the Huskers following her freshman season at Skutt.

In 2018 Jablonski was honored as one of 25 players named to the Omaha World-Herald's Silver Anniversary All-Nebraska team that served as a tribute to the first 25 seasons of softball as a sanctioned high school sport.

With the Huskers Jablonski had an achievement that only one other Husker before or after her has accomplished – (Peaches James) - being name the USA Softball and Louisville Slugger/NFCA National Player of the Week.

That happened in April 2017 when she was honored for her performance in a three-game sweep at No. 22 Wisconsin in which she went 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA over 20 innings, throwing 342 pitches, all in relief.

Jablonski allowed a total of seven runs in three games against a Badgers lineup that was averaging 7.3 runs per game. She was equally effective at the plate, going 6-for-11 with three doubles and a home run. In the first game of the three-game series she was 3-for-3 coming off the bench.

As a junior, Jablonski was named to the NFCA All-Midwest third team. In her 2018 senior campaign Jablonski was a second-team All-Midwest selection. Both of those seasons Jablonski was a second team All-Big Ten honoree. Jablonski-Evans currently is the pitching coach at Gretna East and has been a club team coach with her father Dick.

### Peaches James-Keaton

For a generation, Peaches James was known as the best softball players ever to come from the state of Nebraska. The Papillion-La Vista graduate was a three-time All-Nebraska selection and a four-time Class A state champion before becoming an All-American pitcher at the University of Nebraska.



As a Monarch James set 10 Nebraska state softball records, including consecutive pitching wins (31), consecutive shutouts (19), consecutive shutout innings (162.1), consecutive innings with no earned runs (257.2), lowest season ERA (0.04 in 1999), lowest career ERA (0.13), most no-hitters in a season (11), most perfect games in a season (5), most career perfect games (6) and consecutive perfect games (3).

In 2014 James was inducted into the Nebraska High School Sports Hall of Fame. In 2018 she was also honored as one of 25 players named to the Omaha World-Herald's Silver Anniversary All-Nebraska team that served as a tribute to the first 25 seasons of softball as a sanctioned high school sport. James also was selected as the honorary captain of that team.

By the time her collegiate career ended in 2004, James became the most decorated pitcher in school history. That's the year in which James earned second team NFCA All-America honors. James was named to the Big 12 Conference first team all four years at NU.

Her numbers from that season have stood the test of time for over 20 years, including her 37-9 record with a 0.70 ERA. Those numbers helped James become a finalist for USA Softball Player of the Year.

Also in her senior season James was selected as the Big 12 pitcher of the week four times, a two-time USA Softball National Player of the Week and NFCA Player of the Week, the first Husker to every earn those honor. James also was named a first team Academic All-Big 12 performer.

James set single-season school records with 394 strikeouts and 18 shutouts while holding opposing batters to a .137 average. By the time she graduated, James was Nebraska's career leader in strikeouts (945) and shutouts (44) and ranked in the Top 10 of every pitching category, including No. 2 all-time in victories with 98.

In 2010 James became the fourth Husker to have her jersey retired.
