**Burke Staff / State Track Plan  
Emergency Action Plan (EAP) – Burke Stadium**

1. The following is an Emergency Action Plan for Burke Stadium
2. In the event of an emergency, the most qualified person in the immediate area will be charged with handling the situation until more qualified personnel arrive.
3. If there is more qualified person close-by to charge of the situation, send a player coach to get them.
4. The first objective for the person in charge is to assess for any life-threatening conditions. This includes checking for the following
  - Airway
  - Breathing
  - Circulation

**Call for assistance**

**State Meet:** contact meet physician, OFD, or OPD directly- phone numbers are located at all venues and with all venue directors. Athletic Trainers will be located at all venues

If unable contact onsite help

- If life-threatening conditions exist, the person in charge of the situation will delegate someone to call 911 from the phone located at the center of the main concourse or by the use of cell phone.
- When call 911, be ready to recite the following information: --
  - My Name is \_\_\_\_\_. I need paramedics at the Burke Stadium located at 12200 Burke Blvd.
  - There is an athlete who (Specify/injury or condition), the athlete is located at (specify where).
  - I am call you from the following phone and its number is: \_\_\_\_\_>
  - A designated person will meet the ambulance at the South entrance to the located 125 & Burke Blvd –
- Wait until the operator hands up before you do.

Until the On-site personnel or EMT’s/Paramedics arrive on the scene continue the following things:

CPR/Rescue Breathing, and maintain ABC’s  
Keep control of the situation

Over

Send someone to meet the EMT's/Paramedics

When EMS arrives, be sure to give any pertinent information about the situation.

Examples of this would be:

- Heart Rate
- Blood Pressure
- Respiration Rate
- Allergies
- Other Medical conditions

If there is not a life-threatening condition, the next step is to check for a non-life-threatening conditions that may require medical transportation / assistance

Examples would be the following:

- Open Fractures
- Suspected cervical spine injury
- Close of Open head wound with complications
- Dislocation

### **In the Case of Lighting**

In the case of lightning all participants workers and spectators will be asked to exit through east gates and enter Burke High School through the main south and the auxiliary Gym South Entrance

Fans will be asked to evacuate the stadium until the all clear is given

Play will not resume until at least 30 minutes from the last seen bolt of lightning.

### **In case of a Tornado**

In the case of a tornado warning all participants workers and spectators will immediately evacuate through the East gates and enter Burke High School through the Main South Entrance and the Auxiliary Gym entrance in located at the SW corner of the building

Fans will be asked to leave the stadium until law enforcement personnel gives the all clear.

**In the case of the State Track meet it will be the decision of the Meet Directors as to when the meet will be postponed, cancelled or venue(s) evacuated.**
